Current VLBI Activities in China

Abstract

It takes about 30 years for the establishment of the Chinese VLBI network (CVN). Nowadays, the CVN of five VLBI stations plus a correlation center has gradually but steadily performed astrophysical and geodetic observations as well as the VLBI tracking of space probes. More activities are expected with the ever-increasing international collaborations, such as the East Asian VLBI etc.
